"THE BEAR FACTS"

AAAAA: GOOD MORNING! I'M AAAAA!

BBBBB: AND I'M BBBBB! WELCOME TO THE "BEAR FACTS", YOUR WEEKLY RADIO ROUND-UP OF ALL THE NEWS FROM BISHOP GARRIGAN HIGH SCHOOL.

BISHOP GARRIGAN HAS FINISHED SECOND IN ITS HOME MEET FOR THE PAST THREE YEARS, AND THIS IS THE YEAR WE'RE LOOKING FORWARD TO KEEPING THE BIG TROPHY AT HOME.

SO CHECK THOSE EXPIRATION DATES, AND CONTACT YOUR FAVORITE GOLDEN BEAR TO RENEW ALL YOUR MAGAZINES.

AAAAA: THE ANNUAL VOLLEYBALL AWARDS POTLUCK WAS HELD A WEEK AGO, AND ELEVEN DIFFERENT GIRLS WENT HOME WINNERS. SENIOR STEPH SCHUMACHER WAS NAMED TO THE SECOND ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM, WHILE JUNIOR MICHAELA FROELICH WAS NAMED TO THE CYO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM. THIS YEAR'S MOST VALUABLE PLAYERS INCLUDE KATI LIND AND MELODY SCOBBA ON DEFENSE, AND STEPHANIE SCHUMACHER ON OFFENSE. SOPHOMORE JILL ROSENMEYER WAS NAMED THE MOST IMPROVED PLAYER, AND AMY SCHILTZ WON THE HUSTLE AWARD. OTHER LETTER-WINNERS INCLUDE SOPHOMORE DARCI KOHLHAAS, JUNIORS MELODY SCOBBA AND ANGIE SUNDALL, AND SENIOR JENI BESCH. MRS. JULIE COLLISON IS THE GOLDEN BEAR VOLLEYBALL COACH, AND SHE'S HELPED OUT BY KARA CHRISTIANSON AND AMY MATUSKA.

BBBBB: THE BEARS HAVE STRUCK IT BIG IN FOOTBALL AWARDS, TOO. THE COACHES' ALL-DISTRICT TEAM WAS ANNOUNCED LAST WEEK IN CLASS 2-A, DISTRICT 3, AND FOUR GOLDEN BEAR SENIORS WON TOP HONORS.
